Dear Distance Education Students:

- ♦ on the Salina campus(College of Technology and Aviation) since Fall 1991.

Who should apply?

- ♦ K-State graduates returning for or continuing further undergraduate work.
- ♦ Former K-State students who have not been enrolled in on campus courses for one semester or more (excluding summer semester).

Note: Students who have never attended K-State as undergraduates(but have attended the graduate school) must file a new student application and pay the application fee.

When to apply?

Allow at least five working days to process the application. If you apply during the seven days before the first day of the class and meet the readmission criteria, you will enroll on or after the first day of class. You will be charged a \$50 late enrollment fee. Application for readmission will not be accepted after classes begin for the semester.
