

Advanced Candidates-School Counseling

Each of the following transition points will constitute a formal evaluation of the student through the use of rubrics and portfolio assessment.

Transition Point 1-Admission to the program

Submission of two official transcripts showing completion of Bachelor's degree

Undergraduate GPA 3.0 or higher in two years

Average or higher score on the Miller Analogies Test

Three recommendations from college/supervisor educators or employer, preferably on Department forms

Statement of Objectives indicating area of specialization and interest in school counseling

Transition Point 2- Admission to EDCEP 877, Practicum in Counseling

Students will have completed approximately 24 credit hours (including Counseling Theory) by the end of the semester in which EDCEP 877, Practicum in Counseling, is completed.

Practicum in Counseling must be completed with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Transition Point 3- Admission to the EDCEP 887, Counseling Internship

Successful completion of EDCEP 877, Practicum in Counseling

Successful completion of 75% of required coursework

Transition Point 4- Conditional Licensure

Successful completion of both counseling internships

GPA 3.0 overall in graduate work

Successful completion of all required coursework

Successful completion of the School Counseling Masters comprehensive exams

Successful completion of the School Counseling Portfolio

Submit application for the Conditional School Counselor Endorsement License

Successful completion of the Praxis School Guidance and Counseling Exam

Transition Point 5-Professional Licensure

Successfully complete one-year performance assessment

Submit application for the Professional School Counselor Endorsement license
