

Time to Completion for Teacher Education Graduates

Kansas State University

Spring 2017 Graduates

Candidates must meet a number of requirements to be admitted to the teacher education program. Most candidates are admitted to teacher education by the start of their junior year. In most cases, teacher education requirements can be completed in two years.

The following table includes elementary and secondary education majors in the College of Education. Data for teacher education graduates from programs outside the college are not included in this table (i.e., agriculture education, early childhood, family and consumer sciences, music education).

The table indicates that 85% of the graduates complete their program within two years of their admission to the teacher education program, and 99% of the graduates complete the program by two and a half years.
