- We have been successful on a number of searches. We have hired a new Math Educator, 2 Educational Administration faculty members, a new Adult Educator based on campus, a full time coordinator for the Olathe campus, a new Student Affairs person, a new Counselor Educator, and an individual for OEIE. We continue to interview for a new Science Educator. We have not hired anyone for the Student Services Assistant Dean position.
- An outline for the 2025 priorities has been shared with the Administrative Council and Executive Committee and it is currently being formatted to fit the K-State template. Once complete, it will be shared with the faculty at large, then our alums, etc.
- Currently we are gathering information for the K-State Sesquicentennial celebration. Working to put together the history our College has had with Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs).
- Dr. Herrera is working to bring 100 Ecuadorian teachers to campus this summer.
- The 2 art classrooms on first floor BH have been secured. One room will be a high technology classroom that can seat 50-55; the other room will be fitted for our math and science programs.
